

This is our dress code: 5786

- Hats must be proper black Yeshivishe style hats. No small trendy (felt) fedoras. Hat brims should not be narrow/short.
- No feathers or colored strings around hats.
- **Solid dark black** velvet or terylene Yarmulkes, they should cover most of the head. No designs, patterns, or different shades.
- No emblems, words, pictures or labels on any shirts, sweaters, belt buckles, pants, etc.
- Plain T-Shirts with no words may be brought for sports playing.
- Only your top shirt button may be open.
- Hats and jackets must be worn during Davening and when going out on Shabbos. It is recommended whenever off Yeshiva campus. Suit Jackets should be a conservative color and respectable.
- **Dark Black/ Blue** cotton or dress pants with traditional side pockets.
- No jeans or jean-like pants of any kind, no jogging pants, no corduroys, no pants with pockets in front, no outside pockets, no tight fit pants. Extra pockets, zippers, seams, stitching, strings hanging, elastic ankles, are not acceptable.
- White button-down dress shirts only. No polo style shirts (No colored emblems or colored buttons or stitching)
- Only woolen טלית קטן
- No shorts allowed anywhere. This includes the dormitory and Gym.
- Only **solid black shoes** or sneakers without multiple shades of black. A **very thin** white strip around the bottom of shoe or a **very small** white logo (like a Nike Stripe) would be acceptable. If in doubt, please ask before purchasing.
- Solid black shoes only for שבת
- No High-Tops. No Canvas shoes. No Stitching or designs. No zippers on shoes.
- Socks must be worn at all times during Seder. No short socks allowed.
- No bright-colored, or socks with pictures/designs allowed.
- No colored undershirts.
- No slippers, slides or crocs in the Zal or in class.
- Hair is cut a minimum of every eight weeks, **one even length all over**.
- A suit is to be worn on Shabbos.
- No loud or bright colored sweaters. No words. Hoods may never be worn in Zal.
